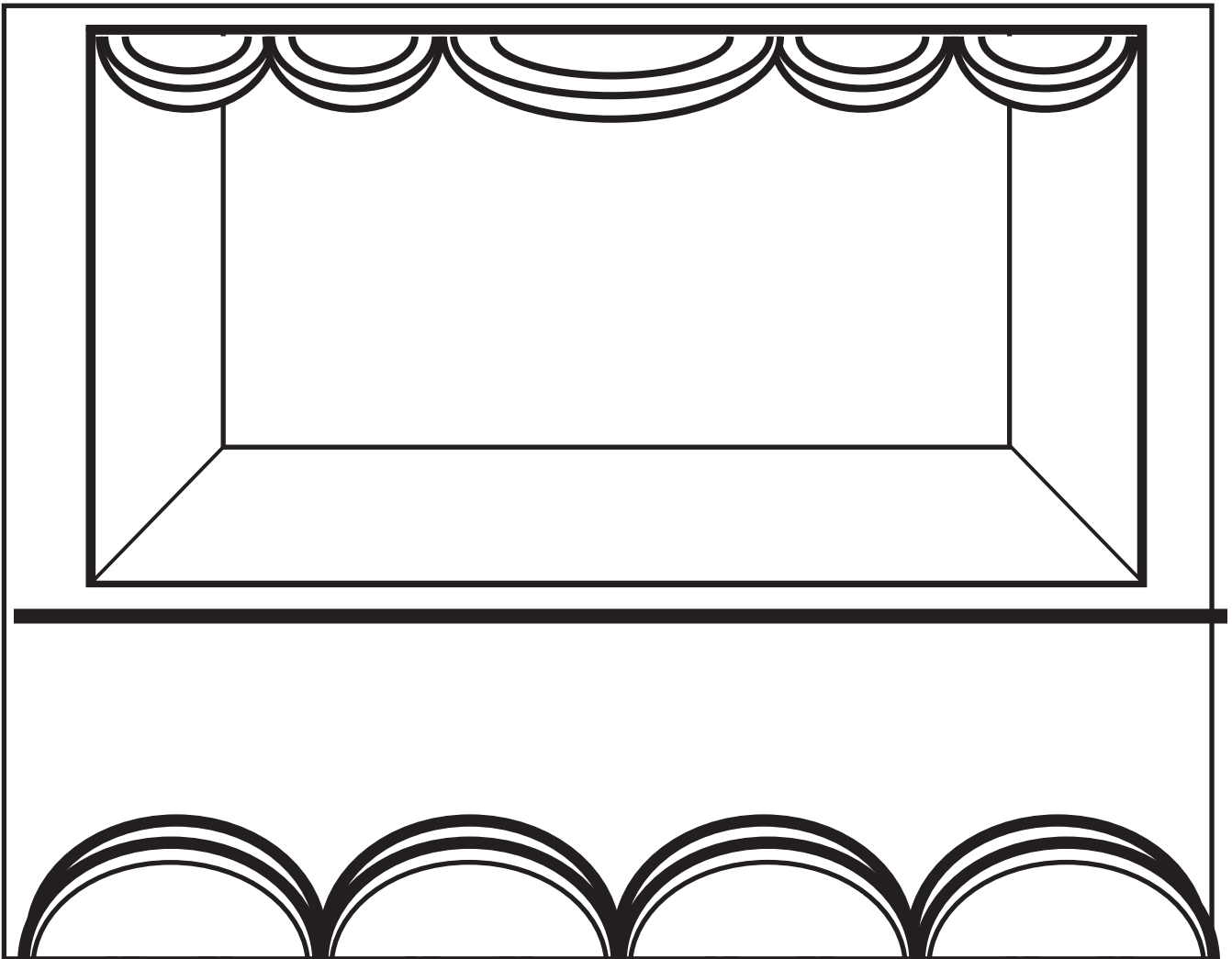


Good Behavior At a Performance
